(2) $p \rightarrow q$.

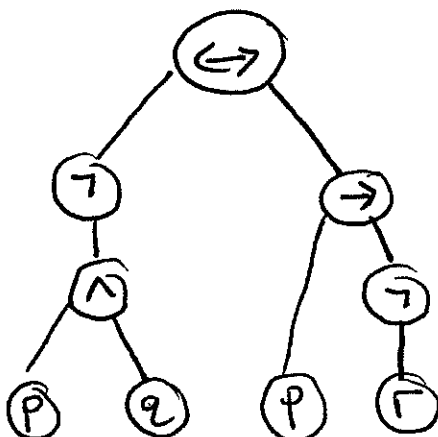
(3) $p \wedge q$.
